

GRANDMOTHER, HAVE THE ANGELS COME?

“Light up Your World” Candles

We suggest you make two and use them while reading the book with a child so you can “touch flames” like the grandmother and granddaughter do near the end of the story.

Materials

- Paper towel or tissue tubes
- White paper cut to the same length as the tubes.
Variation: To make similar in size to the ones in the book, cut a standard tissue tube in half.
- Stapler
- Yellow and/or orange cellophane, tissue paper or foil wrapping paper



Instructions

1. Wrap white paper around the tube and staple on both ends.

Variation: Instead of wrapping in paper, paint the tubes.



2. Cut a flame shape for each candle from cellophane, tissue or wrapping paper.

Variation: With cellophane use more than one layer so it is less transparent.

3. Attach each flame to its candlestick by stapling the lower edge to the inside of the tube.
